The Health Center at Auraria provides medical services to all students, faculty and staff regardless of their insurance coverage, and is nationally accredited by the AAAHC (Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care).

Primary Care, Walk-In Care and Mental Health Services

Includes medical and preventative care for illnesses, injuries and mental health conditions.

Staffed by physicians and medical personnel in Family Medicine, Orthopedics, Sports Medicine, Psychiatry and Gynecology

On-site medications, X-rays, laboratory services and free nutrition counseling.
