To make access to healthcare affordable, the Health Center at Auraria automatically applies a discount of 50% on all charges for self-pay patients. If the Health Center at Auraria is not an in-network provider for your insurance, which can occur with exclusive or managed care provider networks, the out-of-pocket discount is offered.

For Students Participating in a Student Health Insurance Plan

Health Center at Auraria services are paid at 100% for covered benefits, with no deductible, no co-pays and a maximum single prescription cost of \$20.
